Conservation Practice Opportunities:

 Varied options are available for livestock stream exclusion, with ranging cost-share amounts and an additional buffer acreage incentive payment (amount varies based on buffer width)

- Practices available increased rotational grazing
- Other available practices include:
 - o Conversion of row crop acreage to pasture
 - o Conversion of crop/pasture fields to trees
 - o Winter small grain cover crops
 - Nutrient management practices (nutrient management plan writing/revisions, precision nutrient application, PSNT testing, manure injection, etc.)
 - Maintenance funding is available for practices installed that have expired
